

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Thursday, May 12, 2016

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf has, in consultation with the Ministry of Justice, on Thursday, May 12, appointed a Task Force to investigate the just published Global Witness report on Liberia that linked several individuals, and prosecute as the evidence may require. The Liberian leader announced the decision on May 12 following a review of the report which was submitted to the Government of Liberia by Global Witness alleging corruption and bribery on the part of several former and current officials of government. The Task Force is headed by Minister of State Without Portfolio, Cllr. J. Fonati Koffa, who is named Special Prosecutor along with a team of lawyers from the Ministry of Justice. (The Task Force is also charged with investigating and resolving all allegations contained in current and past GAC reports).
