

## **Highlights of the President's Daily Activities**

### **Monday, November 24, 2014**

- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today was at the Freeport of Monrovia during the official handover of a huge donation to the Government and people of Liberia by the Government of the Kingdom of Netherlands and eight other countries of the European Union.

The items included 23 containers of assorted medical supplies and drugs, 21 ambulances and other vehicles, one self-contained mobile laboratory, among others valued at €3.6 million.

The Ambassador of the Kingdom of Netherlands, H. E. Hans Docter welcomed guests for the docking of the Dutch Navy's largest and newest vessel, Karel Doorman – A833 to Liberia to bring in medical supplies and other logistics for the fight against the deadly disease Ebola. Another consignment of relief supplies is expected before December 25, 2014.

President Sirleaf was joined by Foreign Minister Augustine Kpehe Ngafuan and other high profiled government officials and personalities, including the U.S. and European Ambassadors accredited near Monrovia and other representatives of European and International NGOs.
